



ATTENTION EMPLOYEES

Your Job Is Covered By Montana Unemployment Insurance FOR WHICH CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE FUND ARE PAID BY YOUR EMPLOYER

If you become unemployed through no fault of your own, or you are working reduced hours, you may be eligible for unemployment insurance benefits.

You may file an Unemployment Insurance Claim online at uicclaimant.mt.gov.

To file a claim you will need:

- Dates of employment, the business name, address, and phone number of all employers you have worked for in the last 18 months.

If you wish to receive your benefits via Direct Deposit:

- You will need your account number and bank routing number.

If you are an ex-military member:

- You will need to provide a copy of your DD214, Member Copy 4.

If you are not a U.S. Citizen:

- Alien registration card number and expiration date.

If you obtain work through a union:

- The name and local number of your union hall.

If you are a federal employee or were employed by the federal government within the last 18 months:

- Your SF-8 or SF-50 may assist you in filing your claim.
