

Availability of Unemployment Compensation Notice

Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits are available to workers who are unemployed and who meet the requirements of Wyoming UI eligibility laws. Unemployment Insurance (UI) is a state-managed program that offers temporary, partial financial assistance to eligible Wyoming workers who are unemployed through no fault of their own. These benefits help replace lost wages and are funded entirely by employer contributions to the unemployment insurance trust fund.
